You will have experience of working in health, social or voluntary sector with an understanding of the framework of community development principles. You should be familiar with identifying and removing barriers to engagement and finding suitable solutions, have experience of working with volunteers and working in partnership with other organisations.

The role will include working across the community and in people's own homes and will require independent travel across Durham.
