



Raffle Terms & Conditions

By entering the raffle entrants agree to be bound by these rules.

Entry: The cost of entry is £1. Each ticket represents one entry only. All entrants acknowledge that their payment of £1 per ticket to enter the raffle does not guarantee that they will win any prize.

Restrictions: Entry is open to all residents of United Kingdom. Tickets are not for sale to or by anyone under 16 years of age. If anyone is found to be under 16 they will automatically forfeit their right to a prize, this includes winners under 16 years of age where the ticket has been purchased on their behalf as a gift.
