

Yorkshire 3 Peaks Challenge Terms and Conditions

As someone taking part in a fundraising activity in aid of St Cuthbert's Hospice, you agree to the following terms and conditions:

Safety, fitness, and injury:

- Before registering for this event, please make sure you feel able to take part health-wise; we recommend checking in with a doctor if you are not certain. If you have any medical conditions that might affect your taking part, or if something crops up after you have signed up, let the event organisers know so they can find the best way to assist you.
- Your safety is of absolute importance to us. Make sure you follow all safety instructions and any training procedures when taking part in events.
- All participants enter entirely at their own risk, St Cuthbert's Hospice will not be liable for any injury, damage or loss suffered by participants as a result of the participation other than in respect of death or personal injury arising as a result of St Cuthbert's Hospices negligence.
- All participants may be asked to provide the name and number of a person to contact in case of an emergency when they sign up for an event. In the case of an emergency, St Cuthbert's Hospice or third party event organisers (Sky Blue Adventures) may use the emergency contact details provided.
- Please be sure to read any terms and conditions issued by the event organisers and make sure to abide by all the advice to ensure you enjoy a safe and fun event.

Age:

- All participants must be over the age of eighteen to take part in the Yorkshire 3 Peaks Challenge.

Registration and funding:

- Registration fees are non-refundable. The registration fee of £20 is non-refundable.
- I agree to raise a minimum of £200 in sponsorship for St Cuthbert's Hospice. I agree to have raised the minimum sponsorship by March 31st 2024, to be able to take part in the challenge and will pay St Cuthbert's Hospice any additional monies raised no later than 6 weeks after the event date.
- As a St Cuthbert's Hospice supporter, you must ensure you are fundraising legally and safely. You can find guidance on this in our Fundraising Pack and on our website.
- I take full responsibility for any costs attributed to my participation in this event and will not deduct any expenditure from funds raised.

- Unfortunately, the amount raised through Gift Aid will not be count towards your minimum fundraising target. However, this money is still very important to the charity and the people we help, so we hope you will encourage your supporters to Gift Aid their donations where possible. Please get in touch if you would like more information about Gift Aid.
- If an event is cancelled or delayed, for reasons beyond our control, we will attempt to arrange the event to take place at a later date but cannot guarantee this will happen.
- Deferrals: If you let us know that you need to withdraw from the event, we will attempt to rearrange for you to take part at a later date but cannot guarantee this will happen.
 - Any money you may have raised can be rolled over to count for your fundraising total next time, but you will need to pay a registration fee for the next event date.
- Registration fees are not refundable under any circumstances. We cannot be held responsible for additional costs lost due to the event being cancelled (e.g., Travel, Accommodation).
- You have signed up to a third party event that is not organised by St Cuthbert's Hospice but by a third party organisation (Sky Blue Adventures) your details will be passed to the organisers for their records and you may need to confirm further terms and conditions from them / provide further information to be able to participate.
